Ukraine - Georgia

The Ukrainian U-17 girls team had to make its debut match with the host Georgian team 3 days after the start of the championship. Due to the quality of the game shown by the Georgians in their first match, the Slavic girls were considered unconditional favorites of this game.

The expectations of the match in the first half were partially justified - if the scoreboard was in favor of the Ukrainians at the end of the half, the picture of the game left the impression that the Georgian U-17 girls team could have achieved more than a "decent performance" in this game.

However, the Ukrainian girls' team had completely different plans. They did not lose focus in the second half either, moreover - they did not leave a chance for the hosts with their accurate attack and aggressive play in defense, the difference increased periodically and the scoreboard at the end of the match showed the great advantage of the Ukrainians – 38 – 18.

Comments

How would you rate the game?

Coach of Georgia:

First half of the game was better, opponent team was ahead of us with only six goals. But in the second half their attack was more intense and we couldn't manage to keep up with them.

It can be boldly said that these expectations were absolutely justified and an uncompromising battle was held in the hall.

Throughout the game, the teams followed each other point by point and did not allow each other to advance with a solid difference. The teams were able to do this at the expense of maximally mobilized and attentive play both in defense and attack. However, to the praise of the Faroe Islands team, it must be said that the Islands gained a gaming advantage in the second half of the match. And several times managed to get ahead with a 2-3 ball difference. However, despite the fact that the Apennines were able to equalize in the main cases, at the end of the game another 2-ball advantage of the Islands resulted and the Faroe Islands gained a deserved 2 points.
