## Faroe Island – Estonia

The Faroe Islands, like their rival Estonia, played their last game in Group B. Although the Islanders held the match against the group's outsider and their victory was not difficult to predict, the match was further intrigued by the tournament situation. The goal of the Faroe Islands was to take the first place in the group, therefore they needed the largest possible positive difference between the goals scored and received in parallel with the victory, in order to record a better result than Serbia and take the first place - Recall that before the last round, Serbia had a +23, while the Islands had +2, although it is noteworthy that the Serbian team had a much harder opponent in the form of Italy, where it would have nothing guaranteed.

The start of the game turned out to be difficult, after the first 7-8 minutes Estonia, thanks to the good and compact game in defense, did not allow the Islands to advance by a big margin, which forced the head coach of the Faroe Islands team to take a minute break, which is another proof of the strong desire of the nominal hosts to win the match with big difference.

The Estonian girls played freely without any psychological pressure, which made their attacking game more productive and they managed to score 9 goals, which is the best result they have recorded. Recall that in the previous two matches, the Baltic girls managed to score only 5 goals in the first half.

Finally, the first half ended with the score 18 - 9.

The second half followed almost the same scenario - the Faroe Islands periodically increased the lead during the second half and ended the match with a 21-point advantage - 37-16. According to the tournament table, they had exactly the same difference between goals scored and conceded, as the Serbian team. So, the girls from the Faroe Islands needed a Serbian defeat or a draw to take first place.

## Comments

### How would You rate today's game?

*Coach of Faroe Islands:*

I think girls did a very good job. They work harder every time and I'm very proud

*Coach of Estonia:*

I think we did a good job. It was hard at the beginning but i think we managed to go up

*Best player of Faroe Islands:*

I think it was ok.

*Best player of Estonia:*

I think it was pretty good. Our defense was a lot better than the other games.

### What were your expectations before the match?

*Coach of Faroe Islands:*

I expected to win, but I thought the score difference would be much more than it is now.

*Coach of Estonia:*

We expected to just fight and we did till the end.

*Best player of Faroe Islands:*

We knew that the opponents weren't that strong but we still needed to play better and to win.

*Best player of Estonia:*

Well, our previous games weren't that good so we didn't expect much, but i still think that we did as much as we could.

### **What are your plans for future game?**

*Coach of Faroe Islands:*

We are going to play semifinals, there will be strongest teams so we have to be ready and we have to find better strategies and better ways to show ourselves and also to win

*Coach of Estonia:*

To prepare and try to do more. We have really important games coming up, so we need to show ourselves.

*Best player of Faroe Islands:*

To Win and to do better.

*Best player of Estonia:*

Just to do better and learn from mistakes.

## Serbia – Italy

As we mentioned in the review of the match between the Faroe Islands and Estonia, the match between the national teams of Serbia and Italy was crucial in terms of redistribution of places in Group B. Therefore, it can be boldly said that in terms of intrigue, this match was supposed to be one of the highlights of the tournament.

The Italian team needed only to win to get out of the group. And for the Serbian team, not only was it a priority to get out of the group, but they wanted to do it by taking first place - to achieve that, Serbia needed to win by a narrow margin, as mentioned in the previous match review, prior to this game, Serbia and the Faroe Islands had exactly the same number of goals scored and conceded.

Considering all these factors, there was a reasonable expectation that the match would be spectacular.

The first half of the match turned out to be extremely tense, both teams were playing high level handball and the spectators remembered themselves with equally attentive play in attack and defense. The first half of the match was an almost equal game, the Italian team was able to realize its attacks 2 times more and ended the half with a victory - 12-14.

However, as mentioned, from the game picture, this advantage was only fictitious - as the second half resumed, the Serbs equalized and the teams followed each other point by point throughout the second half - sometimes one team had a minimal advantage and sometimes another. The picture of the game changed in the 23rd minute of the second half, when the Serbian team, for the first time in this match, managed to cut the lead with a difference of 3 goals. This handicap was not missed by the Balkans and they ended the match with a victory, with a score of 28-25 and took the first place in the group.

## Comments

### How would you rate the game?

#### *Best player of Serbia:*

It was very difficult game. Results were nearly equal during the whole play. But in the end we got to win.

#### *Coach of Serbia:*

Today's game was very unforeseeable, we couldn't predict how it would end. But happily for us victory was ours.

#### *Coach of Italy:*

It was very equal game. We had possibility to win, but in the second half of the game Serbia managed to beat us. But our girls still did good job.

#### *Best player of Italy:*

We were prepared for today's game. We knew our opponent team's opportunities. Serbia has very strong players. We had chance to win. But at the end of the game we missed a few balls. Anyway game was very tense and interesting.

#### *Best player of Serbia:*
